Dates

- Arrival in Guatemala: Before 1PM on December 28, 2016.
- Departure: Before 1 PM on January 3rd, 2017.

Fees

- 250 USD per participant which covers ground transportation, meals, lodging and materials (have to be paid the first day of the course)
